Rules for the International Softball Federation Photography Competition:

- All photographs must depict softball activity and fans.
- Categories a) Pitching, b) Hitting/Batting, c) Fielding, d) Sliding, e) Crowd/Fan shots, f) Miscellaneous Player shots.
- Three photographs may be submitted for each category.
- Only digital files are acceptable and must meet the following criteria:
 - The photographer must certify that the only modifications made to the photo are resizing, cropping, and adjustment of the brightness, contrast, and saturation levels.
 - Photographs must be original works and landscape or portrait and 2000 pixels wide minimum (for landscape) or 1000 pixels height minimum (for portrait) if in 72dpi.
- Photos may be black-and-white or color.
- Each submission must be accompanied by the below form completed.
- By signing the entry form contestants agree to the rules of the competition.
- By entering this competition the photographer guarantees that he or she is the sole proprietor of the copyright of the photograph and does not and shall not infringe on the rights of a third party. Photographer grants the ISF royalty-free worldwide rights, without limitation in time, to publish and display their work for the promotion of softball.
- The ISF accepts no responsibility for damages that may result from the use of the photographs.
- All photos must have been taken between January 1, 2007 and October 31, 2008.
- Photographs must only depict good competitive playing practices and be in good fair play behavior.
- Depicted players must be in proper uniforms with visible team marks, team name, and location.
- Photographs may be utilized in promotional materials, news releases, on the internet, or any other venue deemed valid by the ISF.
- Photographer credit may or may not accompany such use.
- The jury will be composed of representatives from the international softball community and members of the ISF BackSoftball Task Force.
- The jury's decision is final: correspondence will not be entered into.
- The ISF reserves the right to alter the timetable of the competition or even cancel without prior notice without incurring any liability.
- Winning photographers will be noted via email.
- Photos and the completed forms must be submitted to the ISF Headquarters prior to November 1, 2008, (determined by postmark). Any received after that date will not be admitted. Winners will be announced December 1, 2008.
